We are currently recruiting for self-motivated, responsible team players to work for the above seasonal assignments. These positions include Temporary Full Time positions with terms up to 8 months as well as part time (auxiliary) positions with work on daytime, evenings and weekends.

Our 2022 Labourer 2's must enjoy working outdoors performing regular physical activity that is often repetitive in nature in all types of weather. Preferred candidates will have relevant work experience involving general labour with landscaping, urban forestry, sports field maintenance, or infrastructure maintenance or construction.

These positions will work in a variety of Parks Operations areas including Sport Services, Urban Forestry, Infrastructure, and Landscape. Examples of duties include:

Horticulture/Turf Care Labourer - cutting and maintaining lawns and grounds; planting and maintaining perennials and annuals. Other duties could include assisting in the maintenance of various landscaped, horticultural and turf areas in parks and along road boulevards and medians.

Sport Services Labourer - care and maintenance of sport fields including seeding, irrigating, fertilizing, repairing and cutting turf grass areas. Other duties may include the delivery and cleanup of event supplies and litter in parks and trails.

Urban Forestry – invasive plant removal, planting and maintaining habitat restoration sites, public education and outreach, and trail construction and maintenance.

Infrastructure – park litter control, pressure washing and assisting with the construction, maintenance and replacement of parks infrastructure assets such as playgrounds, fencing, benches and irrigation systems.

Education and training in Horticulture, Resource Management, Turf Grass Management and/or Landscape Construction is an asset. Experience in driving a 3-ton truck, operating rotary mowers, line trimmers, chainsaws, and other equipment used in landscaping, trail maintenance, infrastructure maintenance, or sports field maintenance would be an asset.

Requirements include a valid BC Driver's License (with satisfactory driving record) and completion of a Police Information Check (with no adverse reports).

A CUPE hourly rate of \$30.30 (2022 rates) is offered. Temporary full time opportunities provide an additional 6% in lieu of benefits as well as some health and wellness benefits and ability to participate in an earned day off program. Auxiliary assignments will receive 12% in lieu of benefits. The City has a vaccination policy in effect with requirements for all current and future employees.
